

Robert Klamroth, MD, PhD

Robert Klamroth is Head of the Department of Internal Medicine: Angiology, and Haematology and director of the Haemophilia Treatment centre at Vivantes Hospital Friedrichshain, Berlin, Germany.

He received his MD from the Free University Berlin, and afterward specialised in internal medicine, coagulation disorders and vascular medicine.

Since 1997, Dr Klamroth has helped to design and participated in more than 30 phase 1–4 clinical trials investigating new therapies for the treatment of haemophilia and thrombosis. Over the last years, he has authored over 100 scientific papers and reviews published in journals such as *Blood*, *Thrombosis and Haemostasis*, *Vasa*, *Haemophilia* and *British Journal of Haematology*, and has presented at numerous national and international meetings.

Dr Klamroth is the vice president of for the European Association of Haemophilia and Allied Disorders (EAHAD) and holds membership of various national and international societies in the field of angiology, thrombosis and haemostasis. He also serves as vice president at the German Society of Thrombosis and Haemostasis (GTH).
